ELECTION NOTICE!

2010

*****This bulletin constitutes official notification of nomination and election of Local 567 Section Vice Presidents*****

The election will begin on August 23 and end September 23, 2010, by method of secret ballot. The voting will be by telephone and internet using Ballot Point Election Services. The newly elected Section Vice Presidents will assume office on October 1, 2010 for a term of three (3) years. The election will be supervised by the Election Committee, and will be conducted in accordance with the Transport Workers Constitution, as well as the By-Laws of Local 567 under the following procedures:

- 1) A member, to be eligible for nomination and election to office, shall be a member in continuous good standing of the Transport Workers Union of America for a period of twelve (12) months preceding nomination, and must have attended at least six (6) regular monthly membership meetings during the twelve months preceding nomination, (should this meeting requirement prevent a majority (50%plus1) of the Local 567 Membership from participating in the election process the Local 567 Executive Board shall rule it waived for all candidates.) For purposes of this election, Dues must be paid through the month of July 2010 by 5:00 p.m. CDT on July 15, 2010.
- 2) Nominations shall be by individual petition. Nominees requesting to view membership list can contact Bob Kirk at the Union Hall to schedule an appointment.
- 3) Nominating petitions, to be accepted, must contain each member's signature, printed name, and employee number. The number of signatures on the nominating petition will determine "rank" on the ballot.
*NOTE: A member may only sign petitions from his/her own section. A member may sign more than one nominating petition from his/her section, but may sign only one time for each candidate in his/her own section for office.
- 4) Nominations shall require a minimum of five (5) percent of the signatures of members in good standing from the candidate's section as of, July 23, 2010.
- 5) Petitions must be hand delivered to the Union Office, at the address below, no later than 1700 hours, Friday, July 23, 2010. A receipt of acceptance will be issued for all petitions received.

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- 6) All questions or requests pertaining to the elections must be submitted in writing to the **Election Committee** at the address listed above.
- 7) Balloting material will be mailed to all members in good standing on Monday, August 23, 2010. Online or Telephonic balloting must be completed no later than **11:59 p.m. on Thursday, September 23, 2010**. The ballots will be counted on September 24, 2010 with the results certified by the Election Committee upon completion of the counting.
