AUGUST 2006

The Joint Safety Committee convened on Tuesday, Aug 8, 2006. The following items were discussed:

**Eagles Update:** L. Adams provided update. Team is working on phase 2 of the rollout. The EAGLES scorecard will roll up into the safety and compliance score card. The safety and compliance score card will be presented to D. Campbell tentatively on August 15.

**VPP Update:** J. Green provided update.

**Open Items:**

- (1) High Speed closing doors-
  - a. Facilities will paint on the pavement black and yellow stripes-L. Rios to follow up
  - b. Check conditions of pedestrian doors – L. Rios
  - c. Safety blitz on doors – E. Weldon

**Closed Items:**

- (1) Hand Scanners – Members will be cleaning the hand scanners daily.
- (2) Scissor lifts, removing rails – Facilities bolted down the equipment and now people are modifying it when needed. This item is a problem because we do not have the appropriate equipment on hand for the needed task.

**New Items:**

- (1) TAESL
  - a. All Safety reference to GPM
  - b. Campaign needed to red tag platforms (platforms without railings) that cannot be used in TAESL.
  - c. Build line Fall Protection
  - d. Test Cell Fall Protection
  - e. Will be working with the ladder manufacturing company to ensure all ladders are safe and OSHA compliant.
  - f. T. Rhoads to get with M. Alvey to make 'Frankenstein' more flexible.
- (2) Respirator and qualifications in TAESL.
  - a. TAESL will designate certain shops that use respirators.

For the month of July AFW had 9 injuries. 95% of the injuries were dealing with routine practices and normal actions.
