

JOINT SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT
FOR
MAY 2006

The Joint Safety Committee convened on Tuesday, May 23, 2006. The following items were discussed:

Eagles Update: L. Adams reported to the group that on Thursday, May 24 a training class is going to be held for those who will be inputting data into the scorecard.

VPP Update: The team is close to finishing the four basic elements. It is now time to involve people from other departments and contractors that are on the base. The next meeting is scheduled for Thursday, May 25, at 0900. H. Blake will order a VPP banner.

AFW Health Fair Update: Great feedback from people on base. D. Campbell would like to see the health fair become an annual event. DFW will be holding a Safety Fair June 21, contact M. Wondolowski if you are interested.

OSHA Recordable Injuries: T. Dunleavy reported that for the month of April the base OSHA recordable injuries were 3.03. This is the lowest to date.

Eyewash Station Update: J. Davidson reported that all eyewash stations have been changed in TAESL.

Safety Video Update: J. Davidson will represent the EAGLES program. Target completion of video is the second week in June.

Project Name: Scissor Lift, removing rails

Initiation Date: March 14, 2006

-T. Rhoads reported on an update received via E-mail from T. Lance: A/C Cleaners do not remove the rails. Bays 2/3 do not use the lifts very much but some have to use it to check the APU and at that time the mechanics might have to remove rails. T. Lance will look into finding a solution on this issue.

-It was agreed by the group to add the lifts to the walk around checklist in each area.

Project Name: Dust Complaint, TAESL shops near machine shop

-Vacuuming machines off after use may be a good way to help clean the shops after use.

New Items:

- (1) C. Schultz had a question for T. Dunleavy on the compliance of an acetone tank that is located in TAESL in the paint blast area. After the meeting T. Dunleavy will go with C. Schultz to see the tank.

- (2) People are still walking under the closing doors. The team decided to add black and yellow stripes painted approximately 3-4 feet out under the door where people walk to discourage pedestrians. This will also say no foot traffic.
