1. New Safety Items:

2. Open Safety Items:

- Warehouse - They put the railing in and the work is still in process. Reviewing the following:
 - Speed of forklift – if it goes too fast, it jumps off tracking
 - Crown – working to calibrate system and this is very complex
 - Repairing leg on aisle 9

3. Closed Safety Items:

- Facilities - high bay lamps – some have exploded. Facility Maintenance checked lights and some were replaced with incorrect bulbs. Facilities is researching which were installed incorrectly and replacing with correct bulbs. They should be completed before the next JSC meeting.
- Eye wash stations in structures building doesn't work – it has been tagged out of service and is scheduled to be removed.
- Warehouse – a battery changing station has battery fluid that has leaked and needs to be cleaned. Issue has been addressed.

Self-Audit - Dennis Cassady:

EAGLES / General Safety Update - Troy:

- Will be working to call a meeting.

VPP – Jerry Davidson:

- We might try to separate buildings out to create a VPP status per building. Warehouse is the likely candidate to become the first building at AFW.

Training – Glenn Puleo:

- Working on a new system in Jetnet that warns of expiring qualifications and it's not working as well as they'd like. If there is a training session that is listed on your Jetnet home page that shouldn't be there because it's not a requirement for you, training department requests you contact Lori Smith to have it removed from your record and/or to let her know once you've finished a course. They're still working out the bugs in this system.

IH / SSE – Kim Diep

- Brought several issues for Facilities Maintenance to work on:
 - Eye wash station somewhere on the base has parts and other materials blocking it and shop needs to have material removed.
 - Hearing testing for stock clerks – problems – Do we involve just the group running the forklifts, or the whole warehouse? The noise of the horn on the lift is significant – may need to test the whole warehouse. Questions arise:
 - How do we obtain a cumulative test? Who will pay for it?
 - Hearing plugs only take a few (13) decibels away from the noise itself
 - Reducing the noise level will create other safety issues...especially if lift operators can't hear people or other equipment around them.

Medical/ERT – Kim Ealy/Danny Brigham:

- No update

CSRT – Danny Brigham:

- When in training rooms, the ERT alarm – speaker volume too low, difficult to hear in oven shops and classrooms as well
- Issue with not enough people on the 2nd and 3rd shifts and no one speaks Spanish. Need more volunteers.
- Working on a joint training program for both CSRT and ERT groups to create a "mini mass casualty" situation with 5 – 6 patients in order to practice triaging and see how the group works as a team. Dates set for training 5/26 for the AM shift and 5/28 for the afternoon shift. Daryl expressed interest in having Hillwood leaders com to see this training exercise.

TAESL – Chris Schulz / Leo Dominguez:

- Had safety circle meeting and discussed safety eyewear. 70% performance exhibited. Cindy will be coming for Rx testing.
- Hearing tests - they're determining the other areas of exposure.

Warehouse – Doug May:

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Components / Structures – Leeman Adams:

- Roller system in battery shop – talked with Grainger and they'll be here Thursday to look at the roller system. Crane is against the wall and they'll roll it wherever it's needed.

Hangar – Daryl Marquardt:

- Fall protection – bay 3 change to accommodate winglets scheduled for 5/6 – Facilities hasn't received the plans. Was advised to check with Sam Anderson Thursday.
- Survey for first aid kits – all have been located. We have been through the hangar and we have mapped out where we would like them to be placed.
- Reported a person injured with a nose dock slider spring – he broke his wrist. Bill Stoots will provide a note regarding this safety issue in his daily shift in brief memo.
- Painters who are stripping the aircraft aren't trained in suction cup system – they need this training.
